Actinidia	Kolomikta	(Ornamental Kiwi.) A vigorous deciduous climber which has attractive green leaves tinged with pink and white on the new growth, turning red as the season progresses. Clusters of white flowers during April and early May. HARDY	B
Actinidia	pilosula	An attractive deciduous climber with slender leaves which have attractive white tips during early spring. Clusters of pink flowers from late April into May. More of a twining climber which can be trained into a pillar shape. Sheltered aspect. RECOMMENDED.	B
Akebia	quinata	(Chocolate Vine.) A semi evergreen climber producing reddish purple flowers during spring which have a beautiful vanilla or milk chocolate scent! Can be vigorous if not pruned. HARDY	A
Akebia	quinata 'Cream form'	Again semi evergreen producing clusters of scented cream flowers with purple centres during the spring.	B
Akebia	trifoliata	A vigorous deciduous climber which has attractive bronze foliage on early spring growth turning green as summer approaches. Racemes of small purple flowers which are unscented. HARDY	B
Allamanda	cathartica	(Golden Trumpet Vine.) A conservatory plant producing large yellow trumpet flowers during late spring and summer. Can be left to either climb or pruned and kept as a shrub. Prefers full sun. Min Temp 7°C CONSERVATORY	C
Allamanda	schottii	(Bush allamanda.) Flowers are deep golden colour produced late spring until late summer. Be careful not to overwater during winter months. Min Temp 7°C CONSERVATORY	C
Ampelopsis	aconitifolia	(Monkshood Vine.) A perennial climber which is quite vigorous. Having green foliage during summer turning yellow during autumn before the leaves drop. Small clusters of white non descript flowers during summer but produces small orange decorative berries in early autumn. HARDY	B

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Ampelopsis	brevipedunculata var 'Elegans'	A deciduous shrubby vine which does not become too large. Beautiful young foliage is cream and pink during spring turning to green and white mottled effect during summer. Clusters of small white/green flowers during summer producing purple/blue ornamental berries during autumn. HARDY, but a free draining soil is required or is quite happy to be pot grown.	B
Araujia	sericifera	(Cruel Plant.) An evergreen climber which can be vigorous. White flowers with a tinge of purple during summer followed by large seed pods in late autumn. Min Temp 2°C Stems if broken or pruned produce a sticky white sap which can irritate the skin.	B
Aristolochia	baetica	(Andalusian Dutchmans Pipe.) An evergreen twining climber with greyish green foliage. Small deep maroon flowers during summer. Min Temp 2°C	C
Aristolochia	clematitis	A perennial twining climber which produces yellow flowers during the summer. Can be poisonous if eaten. HARDY	C
Aristolochia	fimbriata	Can be grown well in hanging baskets. A delicate green leaf with silver veins. Small brown and yellow flowers throughout summer. Performs well in semi shade. Min Temp 6°C	C
Aristolochia	gigantea	(Brazilian Dutchmans Pipe.) A very vigorous grower which performs well in the conservatory. The flowers are over a foot long reddish purple in colour with white veins and have a delicate lemon scent. Min Temp 5°C CONSERVATORY	C
Aristolochia	'Kewenis'	A medium sized vine which has glossy three lobed leaves and produces medium sized flowers which are purple/brown in colour, unfortunately the scent of the flower is not quite so pleasant! Min Temp 3°C CONSERVATORY	C
Aristolochia	littoralis	This vine grows to around three/four metres in height. The foliage is bright green and the heart shaped flowers are yellowish green with purple markings throughout summer. Min Temp 5°C CONSERVATORY	C
Aristolochia	macrophylla	(A. durior.) A deciduous climber which can be grown	C

outside if sheltered or in a cold greenhouse. It has large thick green leaves and small yellow green flowers which are often hidden by the foliage during spring.  
Min Temp 0°C

Aristolochia	sempervirens	An evergreen climber which grows well in sheltered locations. I think this plant is beautiful. Small green leaves with tiny yellow green and reddish purple flowers from late spring to early autumn. Min Temp -2°C HIGHLY RECOMMENDED	B
Asarina	'Joan Lorraine'	(Climbing Snap Dragon.) A free flowering twining perennial which produces deep blue/purple flowers with a white throat from April-October. Will grow outside in a sheltered location but best pot grown and put undercover for the winter. Min Temp -1°C SEED AVAILABLE	A
Asarina	'Mystic Rose'	Rose flowers from May-October. Annual if planted outside, perennial if winter protected. Min Temp 2°C SEED AVAILABLE	A
Asarina	'Summer Show'	Mass of pure white flowers from May-October. Min Temp 2°C SEED AVAILABLE	A

Basella	alba	(The Malabar Spinach.) An annual climber if grown outside, but can overwinter if frost protected undercover. Large fleshy green/purple leaves. Flowers are white or pink during late spring and throughout summer followed by clusters of black berries.	A
Begonia corallina	coccinea x teuscheri	(Angel Wing Begonia.) Deep green leaves with white spots. An abundance of red/pink flowers from early spring to early winter. Must be frost protected during winter. Min Temp 3°C RECOMMENDED	B
Berberidopsis	corallina	(Coral Plant.) An evergreen climber with red flowers on pendulous stalks during late summer. Can be difficult if it is not happy with its growing conditions. Sheltered aspect.	B
Bignonia	capreolata	(Cross Vine or Trumpet Flower.) An evergreen climber. Deep orange and yellow flowers during spring and late summer. Grows happily in full sun or semi shade. Min Temp -5°C	B
Billardiera	longiflora	(Purple Apple Berry.) Dark narrow green leaves. Non descript cream flower during June followed by beautiful dark purple/blue ornamental fruit during summer and early autumn. An evergreen climber which does not become too large. Sheltered aspect.	B
Billardiera	longiflora fructo 'Alba'	Cream flowers followed by white fruits. Evergreen but requires frost protection. Min Temp 0°C	C
Billardiera	longiflora 'Cherry Berry'	Cream flowers followed by red fruits. Evergreen but will need some frost protection. Min Temp 0°C	C
Bomarea	edulis	(Peruvian Lily.) Herbaceous climber which has bright pink and green speckled flowers from late spring to early autumn. Can climb up to 10 feet and will survive outdoors if sheltered but best to bring it undercover with some frost protection. Quite happy to be pot grown.	B

Calystegia	hederacea	('Flore Pleno') A vigorous herbaceous twining climber which produces beautiful double pink flowers throughout summer. I find this plant temperamental! Min Temp 0°C	C
Campsis	radicans	(Trumpet Vine.) A rapid growing deciduous climber which is hardy, clusters of trumpet red/burnt orange flowers during summer.	B
Campsis	tagliabuana 'Madame Galen'	Again a rapid growing deciduous climber. Clusters of large trumpet shaped orange and deep orange flowers during summer. Can prove shy flowering if unhappy with its position. Best in a sheltered aspect.	B
Celastrus	orbiculatus	(Staff Vine.) A vigorous climbing shrub up to 10m. Yellow/green flowers during July and August. Early foliage is green but by late summer it becomes bright golden yellow. HARDY	B
Ceropegia	sandersonii	(Parachute Plant.) A robust evergreen succulent climber. The flowers are yellow/green in colour and very much parachute shaped. Min Temp 3°C CONSERVATORY	C
Cissus	striata	(Miniature Grape Ivy.) A vigorous slender evergreen vine which has dark green foliage. Clusters of green flowers in summer followed by deep purple fruits. HARDY	B

Clematis	armandii	A vigorous evergreen climber with dark green glossy leaves and beautiful white scented flowers during spring and autumn. HARDY	B
Clematis	montana Var. Elizabeth	A very vigorous deciduous climber which produces an abundance of pink flowers during spring. HARDY	A
Clematis	montana Var. grandiflora	A vigorous deciduous climber. Masses of white flowers during spring. New foliage is often bronze in colour. HARDY	A
Clematis	montana Var. rubens	A vigorous deciduous climber producing masses of deep pink flowers during spring and complimented by its beautiful bronze/red foliage. HARDY	A
Clematis	montana Var. tetarose	Again a vigorous deciduous climber producing many deep rose/pink scented flowers during spring. Attractive dark bronze foliage. HARDY	A
Clematis	'Princess Diana'	A deciduous climber which can be herbaceous in habit. Red and pink single flowers from summer into autumn. For the plant to perform to its full potential it needs to be established. HARDY	B
Clematis	fasciculiflora	A beautiful evergreen clematis collected by Roy Lancaster. Attractive silver variegated foliage. Clusters of cream flowers during spring. Sheltered aspect.	C
Clematis	tangutica	A vigorous climber. Delightful yellow bell shaped flowers from July-October, followed by masses of feathery seed heads during autumn. HARDY	A
Clematis	'The President'	A deciduous climber but can remain evergreen if sheltered. Large dark purple flowers during summer and autumn. Suitable for any aspect. HARDY	B

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Clitoria	ternatea	(Butterfly Pea.) A climbing herbaceous perennial. Deep blue flowers with a white throat throughout summer. Min temp 5°C	B
Clytostoma	callystegiodes	(Argentine Trumpet Vine.) An evergreen climber producing lilac/mauve flowers during summer Min Temp 2°C	C
Cobaea	scandens	(Cup and Saucer Vine.) A climber which is perennial in a conservatory or as an annual outside. A vigorous plant producing masses of purple flowers during summer. Min Temp 2°C SEED AVAILABLE	A
Cobaea	scandens alba	(Cup and Saucer Vine.) As above but produces masses of white/cream flowers during summer. Min Temp 2°C SEED AVAILABLE	A
Coronilla	glauca 'Citrina'	An evergreen shrubby climber which will need support. Masses of delicately scented pale yellow flowers during late autumn-early spring. Sheltered aspect.	B
Coronilla	glauca 'Variegata'	An evergreen shrubby climber with support or grown as a shrub. Pale green/grey foliage with a cream/white variegation. Scented yellow flowers from autumn to early spring. Very sheltered aspect or cold conservatory. Min Temp 0°C	B
Coronilla	valentina	A vigorous evergreen shrubby climber producing an abundance of golden yellow flowers scented very much like Hyacinths during late autumn-early spring. Sheltered location.	B

Decumaria	sinensis	A small shrubby climber which will remain evergreen if sheltered. Dense clusters of cream scented flowers during late spring.	C
Dregea	sinensis	An evergreen twining climber. Grey foliage with umbels of white and pink heavily scented flowers from late spring. Sheltered location or cold conservatory. SEED AVAILABLE	B

Eccremacarpus	scaber	(Chilean Glory Flower.) A climbing perennial producing many orange and red flowers from late spring-autumn. Sheltered aspect. SEED AVAILABLE	A
Euonymus	fortunei 'Wolong Ghost'	An unusual Euonymus, dark green leaves with silver variegation. Can be grown as a climber with support or as a creeper. Evergreen. HARDY	B

Fallopia	baldschuanica	(Russian Vine.) An extremely vigorous deciduous climber! Dense foliage during summer with masses of white flowers during this time. HARDY	A

Gelsemium	sempervirens	(Carolina Jasmine.) An evergreen twining climber. Clusters of fragrant yellow flowers during spring. Min Temp 2°C CONSERVATORY	B
Gerrardanthus	macrorhiza	(Big Foot.) A plant with a spectacular large tuberous root. Ivy like leaves and small dark yellow flowers. Min Temp 4°C	C

Hardenbergia	violacea	(Coral Pea.) An evergreen climber producing pendulous racemes of rich purple/mauve flowers during late winter and spring. Ideal for a frost free conservatory. Min Temp 1°C	B
Hibbertia	scandens	(Golden Guinea Vine.) An evergreen Australian climber producing a long succession of large golden yellow flowers from early spring-autumn. Min Temp 0°C	B
Holboellia	coriacea	A strong evergreen climber with dark green leathery leaves. White, green and purple scented flowers during spring. Quite happy in shade. Sheltered aspect.	B
Holboellia	latifolia	A fast growing evergreen climber but with more slender foliage than coriacea. Clusters of white tinged purple flowers during spring. Sheltered aspect.	B
Hoya	carnosa	(Wax Plant.) Clusters of white/pink scented flowers from early spring until late autumn. Commonly grown as a houseplant but I find the larger it is the more freely flowering it will become. Min Temp 4°C	B
Hoya	bella	(Miniature Wax Plant.) Delicate evergreen foliage flowering repeatedly throughout the year. Sweetly scented white flowers with a violet centre. Min Temp 4°C	B
Humulus	lupus 'Aureus'	(Golden Hop.) A vigorous herbaceous climber which has bright golden foliage. Requires a free draining soil for best results. HARDY	B

Ipomoea	alba	(Moon Flower.) A robust perennial climber which has pure large white scented flowers from June-October. Min Temp 5°C	C
Ipomoea	'Black'	A vigorous annual climber which has large purple/black flowers with a cerise throat from late May- October.	A
Ipomoea	coccinea	A delicate annual climber which produces an abundance of bright red flowers from late May-October. SEED AVAILABLE	A
Ipomoea	'Heavenly Blue'	A vigorous annual climber with large pale blue flowers and a white throat from June-October. SEED AVAILABLE	A

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Jasminum	adenophyllum	(Blue Grape Jasmine.) A medium sized climber reaching around five feet. Produces flushes of scented white flowers from March-November. Min Temp 6°C	C
Jasminum	angulare	An evergreen scrambling climber from South Africa. Heavily but delightful white scented star shaped flowers from June-August. Min Temp 0°C RECOMMENDED	B
Jasminum	auriculatum	Evergreen low growing shrubby climber, white scented flowers during spring and late summer. Min Temp 6°C	C
Jasminum	azoricum	An evergreen climber which produces masses of white scented flowers from April-November. If pruned after flowering each time the new growth will produce many more flowers. Min Temp 0°C	B
Jasminum	beesianum	Deciduous twining climber which has small red/pink flowers during spring and early summer, will need regular pruning. HARDY	A
Jasminum	bignoniaceum	An evergreen shrub or small tree producing bright yellow flowers on and off throughout the year. Will grow outside if very sheltered but performs better if kept under glass. Min Temp 0°C	B
Jasminum	grandiflorum (Tunisia)	A beautiful semi evergreen climber with an abundance of white scented flowers during summer and autumn. Min Temp 1°C	C
Jasminum	Grandiflorum 'De Grasse'	Again a delightful semi-evergreen/evergreen climber depending on the heat given throughout winter. Flowering from late spring until autumn it gives off the most delightful aroma in a conservatory. Min Temp 1°C	B
Jasminum	humile f.farreri	Italian yellow Jasmine. A woody evergreen shrubby Jasmine. Masses of bright yellow flowers from June-July. HARDY	B
Jasminum	humile f.wallichanum	A large growing shrub like climber with delightful slender foliage. Delicate lemon flowers during late spring and early summer. Sheltered aspect.	B

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Jasminum	humile 'Revolutum'	A shrubby evergreen Jasmine reaching up to six feet. Bright yellow scented flower from May-July and often during autumn. HARDY	A
Jasminum	mesnyi	(Primrose Jasmine.) A vigorous growing evergreen scrambling Jasmine with large semi double soft yellow flowers during spring. HARDY	B
Jasminum	multiflorum	(Star Jasmine.) A freely spreading evergreen shrubby Jasmine. Slow growing. A profusion of sweetly scented white blooms throughout the year if enough heat is provided. Min Temp 2°C	C
Jasminum	multipartitum	A large scrambling evergreen Jasmine which produces large sweetly scented white flowers during spring and early summer. Min Temp 2°C	C
Jasminum	nitidum	(Angel Wing Jasmine.) A semi evergreen vine which has delightful scented white flowers from spring-autumn. Can reach heights up to 15 feet. Glossy dark green leathery leaves. Prefers its roots restricted for best results. Min Temp 6°C	C
Jasminum	nudiflorum	(Winter Jasmine.) A vigorous deciduous climber. Bright yellow flowers on bare stems from late autumn-early spring. Leaves are produced when flowering stops and lasts until new buds are forming. Can be trained as a climber or left to cascade. HARDY	A
Jasminum	nudiflorum 'Aureum'	Similar to the above but I find not as vigorous. Bright yellow flowers with attractive yellow and green variegated foliage. HARDY	B
Jasminum	nudiflorum 'Mystique'	A beautiful form of J.nudiflorum which has bright yellow flowers during winter and delightful white and green variegated foliage. HARDY	B
Jasminum	odoratissima	A species native to Madeira and one of my favourites. Glossy green evergreen leaves with masses of delicately scented bright yellow flowers throughout most of the year if grown in a conservatory.	B

Jasminum	officinale	The common white hardy Jasmine. Can be vigorous if left to its own devices. If pruned each year it will produce more heavily scented white flowers during late spring and summer. HARDY	A
Jasminum	officinale f.affine	A vigorous twining climber which has quite dense foliage. Pink tinged buds opening white and delicately scented. I find this form of officinale easier to contain. HARDY RECOMMENDED	B
Jasminum	officinale 'Argenteovariegatum' (syn variegatum)	Not as vigorous as officinale but produces the same scented flowers. The foliage is delicately variegated with cream and green variegation during spring turning more white and grey/green during summer. Happy in full sun or semi shade. HARDY	B
Jasminum	officinale 'Aureum' (syn Aureovariegatum)	An old cultivar. White scented flowers late spring and summer. Golden yellow and green variegated foliage. HARDY	B
Jasminum	Officinale 'Clotted Cream'	A strong growing shrubby climber producing delicately scented cream flowers during late spring and summer, will remain evergreen if in a sheltered location. HARDY	B
Jasminum	officinale 'Crûgs Collection'	Wild collected in Nepal by Bleddyn and Sue Jones. Clusters of slightly scented large white flowers, late spring and summer. HARDY	B
Jasminum	officinale 'Fiona Sunrise'	Grown for its attractive foliage which is bright golden yellow during the growing season complimented by white scented flowers, late spring and summer.	B
Jasminum	officinale 'Inverleith'	A deciduous Jasmine which can be trained quite happily to grow as a pillar. Bright purple/red buds which open white from late spring and attractive dark green foliage.	B
Jasminum	parkerii	An evergreen dwarf shrub, I do not understand why this is not more popular. Suitable for rockeries or plant borders where the soil is free draining. Masses of small yellow flowers in flushes during spring, summer and	B

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autumn.

Jasminum	polyanthum	An evergreen Jasmine if kept in the conservatory. Grown mainly as a houseplant throughout Europe. The pink buds are followed by clusters of heavily scented white flowers during late winter or early spring. To ensure good flowering the following season, prune hard and replot each year after it has finished blooming. Min Temp 1°C	A
Jasminum	polyanthum variegated 'Greenholm'	A selection of polyanthum which we found in the greenhouse during the early nineties. Attractive cream and green variegated foliage with sweetly scented white flowers during spring. Min Temp 1°C	B
Jasminum	sambac	(Arabian Jasmine.) A species which has many named varieties. A strong evergreen vine with waxy leaves, flowers can be single or double but are all white and delightfully scented and which tend to bloom in flushes throughout the year. Min Temp 3°C	B
Jasminum	simplicifolium	A strong climber, narrow deep green leaves. Sweetly scented white flowers during summer. Min Temp 2°C	B
Jasminum	stenolobum	White scented flowers during summer. Scrambling dark green foliage. Min Temp 1°C	C
Jasminum	x stephanense	A vigorous deciduous climber. The new growth during spring is delicately variegated, turning green as the season progresses. Masses of pink scented flowers late spring and early summer. HARDY	A

lapageria	rosea	(Chilean Bellflower.) An evergreen climbing perennial with wiry stems. Beautiful red/pink bell shaped flowers from midsummer to autumn. Can be grown outside in a very sheltered location but I find it performs better in a shady area of the greenhouse. Min Temp 2°C	C
Lonicera	x brownie 'Dropmore Scarlet'	A vigorous semi evergreen climber with green/blue rounded leaves. Clusters of trumpet shaped scarlet and orange flowers from midsummer to early autumn. HARDY	B
Lonicera	'Graham Thomas'	A large twining deciduous climber which if pruned regularly will produce an abundance of yellow and white scented flowers from late spring until autumn. HARDY RECOMMENDED	B
Lonicera	henryi	An evergreen climber with thick dark green foliage. Flowers are maroon and yellow from late May to August. Suitable for north walls. HARDY	B
Lonicera	henryi 'Copper Beauty'	A robust evergreen climber which has bronzy new growth turning deep green. Yellow scented flowers during summer. Quite happy in semi shade. HARDY	B
Lonicera	'Caprilla'	A semi evergreen honeysuckle with light green foliage. Flowers are yellow and white with a hint of pink on the buds. Very pleasantly scented. HARDY	B
Lonicera	hildebrandiana	(Giant Burmese Honeysuckle.) Evergreen oval deep green foliage. Cream/yellow flowers turning orange with age. Scented. Min Temp 3°C	C
Lonicera	japonica 'Aureoreticulata'	A honeysuckle which grows well in partial shade. Evergreen or semi evergreen depending on aspect. Small white and yellow flowers but grown mainly for the foliage – small green and mottled yellow leaves. HARDY	B

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Lonicera	japonica 'Halliana'	A robust twining climber, semi evergreen. Yellow and white flowers during summer. Will benefit from regular pruning. HARDY	A
Lonicera	japonica 'Mint Crisp'	A semi evergreen climber with delightful green foliage with white marbling. Beautifully scented white and cream flowers turning yellow. A sheltered location with the roots protected will give the best results. RECOMMENDED	B
Lonicera	'Red World'	A woody semi evergreen climber which produces lightly fragrant red/pink and white flowers during summer. HARDY	A
Lonicera	serotina	A vigorous twining climber. Scented red/pink and yellow flowers from midsummer-autumn. Performs well in semi-shade.	A
Lophospermum	erubescens	A free flowering vigorous climber. Large foxglove type flowers which are pink in colour. Will die back in winter if it becomes too cold. Performs better if kept in a conservatory for the winter. Min Temp 0°C	B

Macfadyena	ungis-cati	A vigorous evergreen climber flowering during late spring and early summer. Large bright gold-yellow trumpet flowers. Can be shy flowering if too hot under glass during summer months. Min Temp 0°C	B
